The Sullivan County Historical Society's annual dinner meeting is coming up quickly. It is to be on Thursday, August 17 with the dinner starting at 6 p.m. followed by a short meeting at 7 p.m. and then a talk to be given by Marc Lewis on old time logging tools and implements. The dinner will be held at the Laporte Community Hall at 347 Muncy Street and by the way, there is handicapped parking behind the building and a handicapped entrance in the front that you can get to on a newly installed brick pathway that goes around the building. There is public parking at the Courthouse parking lot, also on Muncy St. Dinners are by pre-paid reservation only at a cost of \$15.00 per person.
